- be based in WA and be available for an interview in Perth if required;
- have a minimum of 10 years experience in the development industry or an associated industry; and
- > complete requirements as stated on the entry form and return completed form with attachments to the UDIA WA office by Monday, October 10, 2016.

Judging process

The UDIA WA Council will assess all submissions based on the criteria and determine a shortlist of finalists. All nominees will be emailed announcing the shortlist of finalists. Finalists will then be contacted by UDIA WA to arrange a time for them to meet with the UDIA WA Council representatives for an interview.

After all finalists have been interviewed, the UDIA WA Council representatives will contact referees before determining the winner. The 2016 winner will be announced at a UDIA WA Leadership Function on Friday November 11, 2016. The Council's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into. Additional merit can be awarded at the Council's discretion.
