- Qualifications (must have a minimum 2 years experience following graduation from undergraduate qualification)
- Career overview detailing professional achievements and contribution to the industry
- Current position
- Career development goals for the next 5 years and an identified path to achieve these
- Ability to take on a UDIA ambassador role for young professionals and be actively involved in the delivery of new initiatives
- Two references supporting your submission - 1 x personal and 1 x professional (*these are additional to the 4 page limit*).
- A high-resolution head-shot (minimum size 3MB) and an electronic copy of your biography.

Self-nomination and third party nominations will be accepted.

Please ensure the UDIA Entry Form is completed and all required documentation is included. Submissions must be complete to be considered.

## Judging Process

Submissions will be considered by a panel consisting of:
